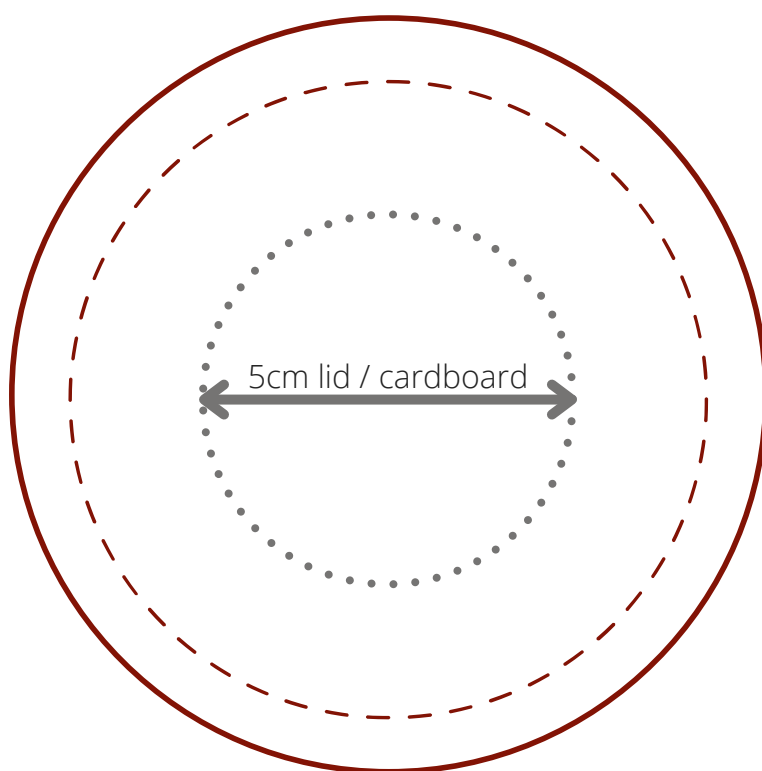


BABY FOOD JAR PINCUSHION

DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS ON WWW.LRCRAFTS.IT

approx.
10 cm diameter
for a 5cm diameter lid



cut along straight red line
stitch along dashed red line

the dotted grey line is the size
of the baby food jar lid:
cut cardboard disk
the same diameter of the lid

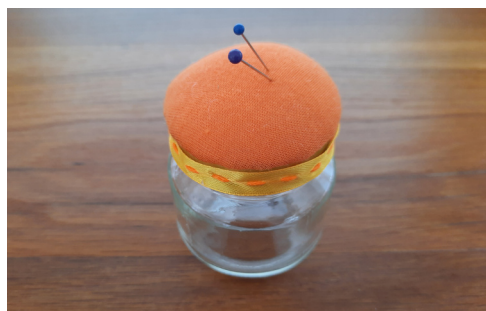
DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS ON WWW.LRCRAFTS.IT

What you need to make your pincushion:

- This pattern (for 5cm diameter lids)
- Baby food jar with screw-on lid
- Fabric of your choice
- Ribbon of your choice, as thick as the jar lid
- Stuffing material (polyester, cotton, filling material for dolls or pillows...)
- A piece of cardboard at least the diameter of the lid
- Hot glue
- Needle and thread (also embroidery floss, if you want to decorate your ribbon)
- Scissors and a seamstress measuring tape

Optional

- Small magnet

Quick step-by-step instructions:

- Check if the size of your jar lid is 5cm as shown on this pattern. If not, scale accordingly.
- Print this pattern on paper or cardstock.
- Cut the fabric according to the pattern.
- Cut a cardboard disk the same diameter of your lid.
- Stitch all around your fabric circle circumference using a basting stitch (an easy running stitch), following the pattern
- Pull the thread slightly to obtain a small rounded sack.
- Stuff the sack with stuffing material.
- *Optional*: add a small magnet inside your filling material.
- Add the cardboard disk in the sack and cover all the filling material
- Pull the thread tight and fix it to close the sack.
- Glue the cushion on the lid with hot glue.
- Cut a lenght of ribbon the same size as the lid external circumference.
- Decorate your ribbon as you wish.
- Attach the ribbon to the lid border with hot glue to cover it entirely.
- Pincushion ready!



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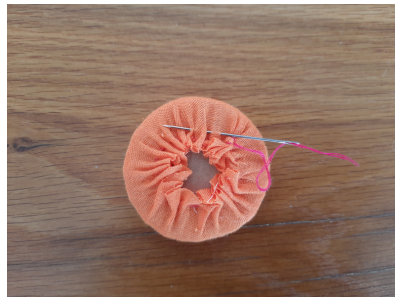
